## DEAD OR ALIVE\*

(\*preferably dead)



If you see floating dead squid or octopus, collecting the carcasses would be of value for research being undertaken on Hawaii's resident deep-water whales and dolphins by Cascadia Research and the Wild Whale Research Foundation. The carcasses will be used to determine potential prey species in the area and be analyzed for stable isotopes/fatty acids. Any squid or octopus found should be collected and placed on ice or frozen. Once collected, call Dan McSweeney at the Wild Whale Research Foundation at 808-324-7056. There will be a reward for the first person to collect three or more squid. We will arrange a pickup of the squid at Honokohau Harbor or in Kailua-Kona.
